General Guidelines for Submission of Abstracts:

Abstracts are open to all research in nursing science; only abstracts derived from completed research will be accepted. Abstracts that have been presented at other conferences will be accepted for submission. Abstracts will be accepted from faculty, students, and DUHS nurse researchers. **Posters must be submitted electronically.**

Abstract Guidelines:

Your Abstract Should Include the Following Components (underlined):

The body of the abstract (aims through conclusions) is limited to 250 words in total. The title and authors are not included in the word count.

TITLE: A brief statement of the nature of the investigation or purpose of the project.

AUTHORS: All authors and affiliations.

Under the authors indicate whether this is a student, faculty or DUHS nurse research submission.

AIMS: The overall purpose, research question, or study hypothesis.

METHODS: The study or project design and methods (sample, procedures, measures, and/or data analysis).

Please note that the study can use qualitative or quantitative methods.

RESULTS: The study or project findings or products

CONCLUSIONS: The overall impact of findings and relevance to nursing, healthcare, or health policy.

- ◆ **October 1** - You will be notified if your abstract is selected.
- ◆ **November 1** - Poster submission deadline. Please submit your electronic poster to libby.ladd@duke.edu.
