Tuition Rate

- \$30,952 Estimated Per Semester
- Students who enroll in more than 18 credit hours in a semester will be charged the standard tuition for the semester, plus tuition at our graduate per-credit-hour rate for credits taken that exceed 18.
- Students enrolled in less than 12 credit hours in a semester will be charged tuition at our per-credit-hour rate for that semester.
