### Gala: Details to Ensure a Memorable Event

The Gala site (<u>link</u>) on the DUHS Nursing intranet is brimming with information to ensure that those planning to attend the event have the details they need to ensure a memorable evening – or weekend. The Gala site will be kept up to date, with the most current information available.

The FON Gala is free for Duke Nurses. For those who would like to invite a guest, the fee is \$25 per person. Guest fees are payable when registering; payment options include debit cards or these major credit cards: American Express, Discover, MasterCard and Visa.

Since Durham has implemented metered parking throughout the city center, remember to pay attention to new signage that indicates where parking is allowed. Event parking (\$3 cash upon entry) is available at the Durham Center Garage, 300 West Morgan Street, just across the street from the Durham Convention Center.

Plan to arrive at the event at 5 p.m. or soon after to enjoy socializing with colleagues. The bars will be serving soft drinks, wine and beer at no charge, and other beverages will be available for purchase. The bars will close promptly at 5:40 p.m. so that everyone can gather in the Grand Ballroom for the Award Ceremony. The bars will remain closed throughout the ceremony, reopening when dinner is served. The Award Ceremony will last approximately one and a half hours.

The Gala is semi-formal, so plan to dress up and enjoy the evening. And for those who want to extend the occasion, the Durham Marriott City Center (<u>link</u>), which is adjacent to the Durham Convention Center, is offering a discounted rate of \$139 per night for Friday, Nov. 3, and Saturday, Nov. 4, for anyone attending the FON Gala.
