Tip #3: <u>Do provide Sara the most up-to-date version of your paper on or before your appointment time.</u>

Tip #4: <u>Do</u> detail a list of your specific questions and concerns when you submit your paper for review. The more specific, the better!

Tip #5: <u>Don't</u> expect Sara to edit your paper for you. This service is designed to help you learn to write better and then edit your own papers using what Sara teaches you.

Tip #6: If you have a follow-up call scheduled, <u>Do</u> create your free Skype account and request to add **sdhauber** as a contact at least 24 hours prior to your appointment, or plan to contact Sara at 919-913-8067.
